Who We Support

To be eligible for our services, a single parent must:

- Reside in Weld or Larimer counties;
 - Earn at or below 225% of the Federal Poverty Level, which for a single parent with two children is \$61,470;
 - Have at least one child aged 15 or younger living with them the majority of the time; and
 - Be ready to transform their lives through the power of education and training.
